All Saints Day - Saturday, November 1

We remember those excellent servants who live in God's Presence and are part of the Kingdom.

Mass at 7 pm

All Souls Day - Sunday, November 2

Mass at 10 am with a special remembrance for those from our parish who passed away within the last year.

Remembrance Day - Tuesday, November 11

Mass at 8:30 am. Remember those who have defended freedom and peace. Buy and wear a poppy.

Ways to remember those who have passed away:

- ❖ Vigil Candles at the statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary help us "pray without ceasing" for the five days the candle is burning. Suggested donation \$3. For an additional \$2, a full colour photo card and envelope is available to send to family or friends.



- ❖ Mass can be said for the repose of a soul. Mass cards to send to family members are available for a donation of \$10. Available from Melita in the Parish Office.
- ❖ **New** A book of memorial cards and other tributes to departed loved ones will be on display in the Gathering Area. You are invited to submit a memorial card or other tribute (maximum size 8.5" x 11") for anyone who passed away at any time.
- ❖ Funeral Memorial Cards of those who have passed away in the last year and had funerals in our church will be on display in the Gathering Area.
- ❖ The Books of Remembrance for St. Cecilia and the former Sacred Heart Parish will be in the display case from Sacred Heart Parish.
