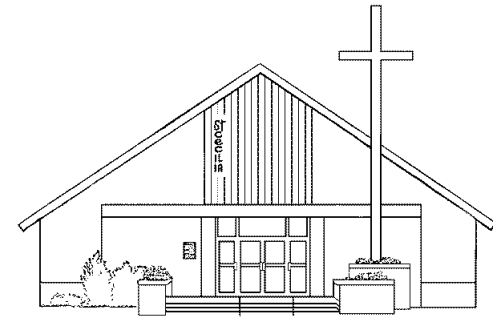

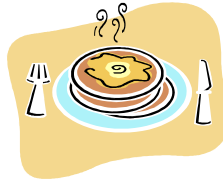

Annual General Meeting and Elections to Pastoral Council

All parishioners are invited and encouraged to attend the Annual Meeting,

The purpose is to report the activities and finances of the past calendar year and elect members to the council committees.

An information package will be available March 7 & 8. It will contain the 2008 Annual Meeting minutes, 2009 committee reports, a message from Fr. Weckend, a financial accounting of 2008, and budget for 2009. Some of the information will be reviewed at the meeting with time for questions.

Constitution Changes

Pastoral Council has approved a number of changes that will be voted on at the meeting. A majority vote of 2/3 is needed to amend the constitution. Copies of the current constitution and the proposed changes will be included in the package.

Pastoral Council Committee Positions

Terms of service are 2 years unless otherwise noted, to a maximum of 2 terms. A position may be held by 2 people.

Committee representatives needed in these areas:

- Buildings and Grounds (1 year term)
- Deanery
- Ecumenism
- Finance
- Parish Community Building (1 year term)
- Social Justice/Pastoral Care
- Stewardship
- Vocations Awareness

Buildings & Grounds - oversee maintenance and operation of the parish buildings.

Deanery - exchange ideas with other parish deanery representatives.

Ecumenism - participate in the Rosemont Area Churches Ecumenical Association.

Finance - administer parish financial affairs.

Parish Community Building - assist in developing events to bring people together.

Social Justice/Pastoral Care - support those in need and promote awareness of social issues.

Stewardship - help each member of the body of Christ share God's gifts of time, talent, and treasure.

Vocations Awareness - promote awareness of the four vocations (married, single, religious, ordained).
