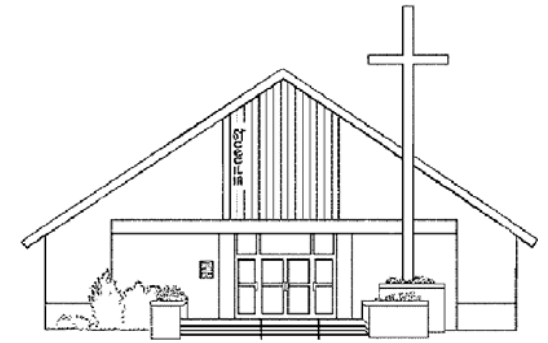

We, like Jesus in the Garden, have to make peace with the fact that we are soon to exit this life, alone, but for hope in God.
