2:20 pm - Centennial Celebration begins with Welcome

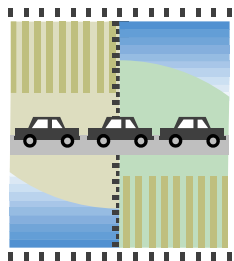
2:30 - Trumpet Blast and Grand Procession.
