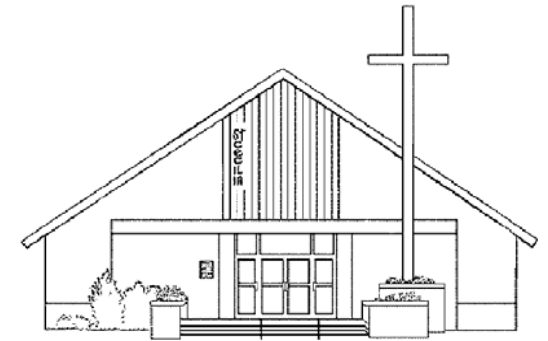

Their rent is \$1500/month and there is telephone, groceries, supplies, clothes and other incidentals that need to be purchased. The father is a Chef who has worked in 5 star restaurants. Some needs yet to be met are: double bed, dressers & end tables and financial help (cheques may be sent to the Archdiocese marked "Iraqi Crisis Fund").
